



BIG TRUTH: GOD IS MY CREATOR

Job 10:3; 8; Psalm 95:6; 100:3; 139:13-16; Isaiah 44:24

BIBLE VERSE: GENESIS 1:27

"So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

BIG IDEAS

- God made Adam and Eve.
- God made me.
- God made man and woman in His image.
- God made us with purpose.

BIBLE STORY: GENESIS 1:26-28; 2:15

God is the good Creator. He spoke everything into existence. Not only is He the creator of the heavens and the earth, but He is the creator of man and woman. He created Adam and Eve with His own hands and He breathed life into them. God created every person and gives mankind a purpose. He created man and gave him dominion over the living creatures on the earth.

STORY: CREATION

God created everything. Everything we see, hear, feel, taste, and that exists was created by Him. Not only did He create everything, but He created everything perfectly, including humanity. He created mankind in His very image and likeness to reflect His worth. All of creation was made just like He wanted and designed it to be. To His delight, God looked at everything He made and declared that it was good. All creation exists for God, is good, and was created to bring Him glory.

STORY: CREATION GOD IS MY CREATOR

GOD MADE ME

Prepare a scavenger hunt for your child that involves her finding different things that tell about her. For example, you can include your child finding a special toy or article of clothing that belongs to her. Once she finishes the scavenger hunt, talk with her about how God made her and designed her as she is. He created her for a purpose to glorify Him.

DISCOVER IT: (Use the passage to illustrate the Big Truth.) Genesis 1:26-28; 2:15.

THINK ABOUT IT: (Use the commentary to reinforce the Big Truth.)

After God created the heavens and the earth He created the animals and all living things. He spoke these things into existence. When God created the first man, He fashioned man with His hands. He used dirt to make the very first man and He breathed air into his lungs. After He made the first man, He made the first woman and He gave her to the man as a helper. God created people as male and female as part of His divine design. He created two genders to enable people to be in a relationship with one another. He created male and female to reflect Himself to the world. The very first people were created with a purpose to take care of the earth and all that was in it. God gave them everything that they needed to live and be happy. They brought God glory by fulfilling His purpose for their lives. He also creates every person born after them. All life comes from Him. He fashions each person in his or her mother's womb and gives them life. Each person is born with a purpose, or way that he or she can bring God glory uniquely. We are all made in God's image and we are given a purpose. Being created in God's image gives us value and worth. No one is by accident. We are all from God and made for God.

TALK ABOUT IT: (Use the questions to discuss the Big Truth)

- What purpose did God give to Adam and Eve? (He told them to multiply on the earth.)
- What purpose did God give to every person created? (To be in a relationship with Him and to glorify Him.)



As a family, memorize Genesis 1:27. Lead your child in a discussion about how each of us is created in God's image.

Take a trip with your child to your local park or playground. Ask your child to point out some of the differences in the people at the park. Talk with your child about how the differences in each of us show God's great power and creativity. Our differences in hair color, height, skin color, size, and shape all reflect God's great glory.



Help your child create an "About Me" book using pictures and craft materials. The book should show your child's personality and different traits that he has. Talk with your child about how God made him in a unique and special way. We are all made in a unique and special way for God's purpose, which is to bring Him glory.



Spend some time this week showing your child pictures of when they were younger. Talk with your child about their different attributes and personality traits. Remind your child that they are created by God to glorify God.



Spend some time this week as a family praying and thanking God for creating each of us.
