## STORY: NEW CREATION

### BIG TRUTH: GOD IS ALIVE

Job 12:10; 33:4; Isaiah 42:5; Jeremiah 10:10; Matthew 16:16; Acts 17:24-28; 1 Timothy 6:13

### BIBLE VERSE: JOHN 1:3-4

*“All things were made through Him, and without Him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.”*

### BIG IDEAS

- God is life.
- God gives new life.
- God is making us alive.

### BIBLE STORY: ACTS 9:1-31

God is the God of all life, physical and spiritual. Saul received physical life from God at his conception, but he lived his life persecuting Christ’s followers until God changed Saul’s life. On the road to Damascus, Saul saw the light of Christ and believed. Saul received spiritual life, or new life from Christ when he believed and his life was never the same.

### STORY: NEW CREATION

Part of the beauty of the gospel is that God does not just rescue us from the power of sin, but He is also making everything new. God offers new creation to those who place their faith in Jesus. This newness comes in two ways. The first is that by breaking the power of sin, Jesus is making men and women into brand new people with new identities. Second, God is not only making people new, but He is also going to make a new heaven and a new earth for us to live on and worship Him in.

### BIG AIMS



#### Every child should know that:

- The church is God’s family
- The Christian life cannot be faithfully lived apart from the local church



#### Every child should feel:

- Loved by the church family that God has placed them into
- Love for their church family



#### Every child should:

- Participate in their local church
- Serve someone within their local church



#### Every child should want:

- To grow together in Christ with other members of God’s family

### FAMILY DEVOTION: ALIVE IN CHRIST

Before Saul knew Jesus, he was spiritually dead. He was lost in his sin and was not really living. After he encountered Jesus, he began to really live and became alive in Christ.

# STORY: NEW CREATION

## GOD IS ALIVE

### BIBLE VERSE: JOHN 1:3-4

*“All things were made through Him, and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.”*

#### God is a living God.

- God has always existed.
- God is one God in three persons.
- The three persons of God: the Father, Son, and Spirit, have always existed.
- God is alive and living.
- God is not an inanimate God. He is not made of stone or human materials.
- He exists and lives among us.

#### God is the giver of life.

- All life is from God because God is life.
- Nothing existed before God created it.
- Everything exists because God gives life.
- All things have life because God is a living God who creates life and sustains it.
- We live and breathe because God breathed life into us.

#### God gives new life.

- In the beginning, God, in His three persons, created life.
- God sustains life and He continues to allow life on earth.
- God brought light to the darkness of the earth when He sent Jesus.
- Jesus came to the world to bring new life to those who believe.
- All who believe in the work of Jesus receive new life.
- Jesus is the light sent to drive the darkness out.

### BIBLE STORY: ACTS 9:1-31

*Saul's Conversion*

#### Opening Illustration:

Gather together a flowerpot, potting soil, and grass seeds. Ask the children to help you put the potting soil into the flowerpot. Next, give each child a few grass seeds and ask them to push the seeds into the soil. Next, use a water bottle to help the children water the seeds. Set the pot somewhere safe so they can watch the grass grow. Talk with the children about how our world now is broken and dying, like the flowerpot was empty, but Jesus is making a New Creation. The flowerpot will have new life in it when the grass grows.

# STORY: NEW CREATION

## GOD IS ALIVE

### BIG IDEA: GOD IS LIFE.<sup>1</sup>

#### God is the Creator of all things.

- Nothing creates itself, or begins existing on its own.
- We are not able to create life.
- God is the source of all life.
- Not only is He the source of all life, He sustains all life.
- He creates all things and gives life because He is life.



Have the children define the word “life” and then make a list of living things in the world. Next, ask the children to name the source of life for each living thing that is on the list. Remind them that God is the source of all life because He is life.

#### Everything has life because of God.

- We would have no life if it were not given to us by God.
- God gives us our life.
- He breathes breath into our lungs and He holds our life in His hands.
- He is the beginning of everything.
- He has always existed and it is through His power that everything else exists.

#### God is our life.

- Even those who do not follow Christ still receive life from God.
- Everyone receives physical life from God because only God gives life.
- God is our source of living and breathing.
- He is the reason we even exist on the earth.
- He continues to keep the earth functioning and people living.
- He controls life and death and because of Him, we have life.

*Who is our source of life? (God is the source of all life.)*

1. 1 Timothy 6:13: All life is given by God. He is the source of all life.

# STORY: NEW CREATION

## GOD IS ALIVE

### BIG IDEA: GOD GIVES NEW LIFE.<sup>2</sup>

#### We are dead in our sin.

- Every person is born with a sin nature that causes them to rebel against God.
- Every person owes a sin debt.
- The wages of sin is death.
- Our hearts are wicked and sinful because of our sin nature.
- We are all dead in our trespasses.
- We cannot make ourselves new or create a new life for ourselves.
- Saul was dead in his sin.
- He did not follow God or see the truth.



Bring in dry, dead leaves and fresh, living leaves. Ask the children to describe the differences in the two types of leaves. Remind the children that God gives new life to those who have saving faith in Him.

#### God gives physical life and spiritual life.

- God breathes breath into our lungs and He gives us new life in our hearts.
- Saul had physical life, but He was spiritually dead.
- He lived in rebellion to God.
- He sought out Christ's followers to kill or imprison them.
- God gave Saul new life.
- He gave him life spiritually.
- God gives us new life spiritually when we have saving faith in Jesus.
- He makes our hearts new and makes us new creations.
- We have new life because of God.

*From whom do we receive new life? (We receive new life from God.)*

*How do we receive new life? (When we have saving faith in Jesus, we receive new life.)*

2. 2 Corinthians 5:17: Anyone who has repented of his sin and placed his faith in Christ becomes a new creation.

# STORY: NEW CREATION

## GOD IS ALIVE

### BIG IDEA: GOD IS MAKING US ALIVE.<sup>3</sup>

#### Our old hearts make us dead, but our new hearts give us life.

- We are dead in our sin, but we do not have to remain that way.
- God made a way for us to be alive.
- He sent His Son to pay our sin debt and now we have freedom in Him when we believe.
- Our faith in Jesus gives us new hearts.
- God continues to make us new through His Spirit.



Give the children a blank piece of paper and markers. Ask the children to draw a picture of what they were like when they were babies or little children. Next, ask the children to draw a picture of what they are like now. Talk with them about how God makes us alive through Christ and we become more like Christ.

#### We are always becoming new as we become more like Christ.

- God's Spirit works inside of us to make us like Christ.
- God continues to work in us, making us new creations.
- His Spirit works to take away the old sinful behaviors and gives us new righteous behaviors.
- God gave Saul new life on the road to Damascus and He continued making him new through His Spirit.
- We are all like Saul. We receive new life when we believe and then the Spirit continues to make us new.

#### We are made alive through Christ.

- We are dead in our trespasses, but when we believe in Jesus, we are made alive.
- Just like Jesus died on the cross, was buried, and then raised again to life, we are dead and then raised to a new life in Christ.
- We have new desires and new behaviors when we are in Christ.
- His Spirit works inside of us to make us more like Him every day.

*How are we made alive? (Through Christ we are made alive.)*

*Whom do we become more like when we have saving faith? (We become more like Christ when we have saving faith.)*

3. Ephesians 2:5: Through Christ we are able to receive new life. Through the Spirit we are made more alive in Christ daily.

# STORY: NEW CREATION

## GOD IS ALIVE

### HOOKS



#### The New Life

Have the children look up and read the following verses: Genesis 2:7, Ezekiel 36:26-28, 1 Peter 3:18, and John 6:63. Talk with the children about what each verse says and means. Lead them in a discussion about how God gives new life to those who believe.



- We are all born spiritually dead because of our sin nature.
- Just like Paul, we are living dead lives until we meet Jesus.
- When we repent and believe in Jesus, we are given new life in Him.
- We are continually made alive in Christ as we grow in our relationship with Him.



#### Dead or Alive

Bring in several pictures of dead objects, such as dead trees, dead flowers, dead grass, etc. Also bring in pictures of living objects. Mix the pictures up and ask the children to yell “dead” or “alive” when you hold up a picture. Talk with them about how we are all dead in our sin until we have a relationship with Jesus.



- Because of our sin nature, we are all born spiritually dead.
- We are living dead lives with no hope when we do not know Christ.
- When we meet Christ, repent of our sins and believe in Him, we receive new life and are continually made new through Him.
