"Yet he is actually not far from each one of us, for 'In him we live and move and have our being', as even some of your own poets have said, 'For we are indeed his offspring.' Being then God's offspring, we ought not to think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone, an image formed by the art and imagination of man. The times of ignorance of God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent."

BIBLE PASSAGE: ACTS 17:22-34

Read Acts 17:22-34 this week and make notes in your journal. Answer the questions below in your journal as well:

- How did the altar to the unknown god reveal that the Athenians had glimpsed the true God in the natural world?
- What truths does Paul reveal about God in verses 24-31? Make a list in your journal.
- How do the truths that Paul reveals about God present the Gospel to the Athenians?
- What are the two responses to Paul's revelation about God?
- How are these two responses still prevalent today when the Gospel is presented?

Read and meditate on Acts 17:22-34 this week. Use the questions below to guide your meditation:

- Ponder God's command to repent. Do you live as if this command is for all people? What in your life reveals that you believe it is for all people?
- Consider the ways God sustains life. Do you worship Him as the Sustainer of life? Why or why not?
- Ponder God as the judge of all people. Do you share this truth with people when you share the Gospel? Why or why not?



Pray with your parents this week.

- Ask God to guide you to share the full truth of who God is and to call people to repent as God commands them to.
- Pray with your small group leader this week. Pray specifically for people who do not see God as the Creator or Sustainer of life.



Memorize Acts 17:27b-30 this week.

- Ask a friend or your parents to help you memorize these verses.
- Make a list of some of your accomplishments in life. Place a check next to the ones that you consistently praise God for. Place an "x" next to the ones that you have taken credit for. Commit to praise God for all that He has given you and to worship Him as the Creator and Sustainer of all life.
- Meet with your small group leader to discuss God as the judge of all people. Create a list of people in your life who do not know Christ as their Savior. Choose one or two to share the Gospel with and practice how you will share the Gospel with them during your meeting with your small group leader.
