#### **BIBLE VERSE: ACTS 26:22-23**

"I have had the help that comes from God, and so I stand here testifying both to small and great, saying nothing, but what the prophets and Moses said would come to pass: That the Christ must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, He would proclaim light both to our people and to the Gentiles."

#### **BIG IDEAS**

- We testify with God's help.
- We testify of Jesus' suffering.
- We testify of Jesus' victory for Jew and Gentile.

#### BIBLE PASSAGE: ACTS 25:22-26:32

#### KNEEL: LIVING ON MISSION

- Consider Jesus' suffering. How can you testify of His suffering to others?
- Ponder the victory Jesus acquired for Jew and Gentile. How can you tell others of this victory and its significance to their lives?



#### Pray with your parents this week.

- Ask God to help you boldly share your testimony with others.
- Meet with your small group leader this week for prayer. Ask God to help you understand Jesus' suffering so that you can testify of it to others more clearly.



#### Memorize Acts 26:23 this week.

- Ask a friend or your parents to help you.
- Write out your personal testimony this week. Ask your parents to help you think through your testimony and work on a presentation of it that shares Jesus, His suffering, and His victory.
- Meet with your small group leader this week to share your testimony and practice sharing it with other people. Commit to share your testimony with a lost friend this week.
