BIG TRUTH: SIN IS A REJECTION OF GOD

Genesis 6:5; Isaiah 53:6; 2 Kings 17:15; Jeremiah 10:1-15; Isaiah 44:9-20

BIBLE VERSE: ROMANS 1:25

“Because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.”

BIG IDEAS

- Sin leads us to doubt God’s goodness.
- Sin leads us to believe the lie that God is not enough.
- Sin leads us to reject God’s rule and reign.

BIBLE PASSAGE: ROMANS 1:18-25

KNEEL - I AM AN AMBASSADOR

The Kneel Year is an exploration of what it means to worship God with our all (Luke 10:26-28). Worship is not something that is limited to a service once a week, but instead occurs every day, in all of life. We are unceasing worshipers. Worship never stops, it only changes directions. In order to worship God with all of our heart, soul, strength, and mind, we must embrace our identity as image bearers. It is out of that identity that we can begin to live for God’s glory in all of life (Colossians 3:17).

SERIES AIMS



Every student should know that...

- The gospel is the good news of Jesus Christ that brings salvation to sinners.
- Salvation comes by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone.
- Jesus followers have been trusted with the gospel in order to share it with others.



Every student should strive to...

- Share the gospel each month with at least one person who does not know Jesus.
- Practice sharing the gospel using multiple different tools or methods.



Every student should feel...

- Humbled that as believers we have been entrusted with the glorious gospel of our Savior.
- Satisfied in Jesus as the only true Savior



Every student should want...

- To grow in awareness of the false saviors they are tempted to put their hope in.
- To have a softened heart and love for people who are lost
- To take advantage of opportunities to share the gospel with people in their lives who need Christ

STUDENT WORKOUT:

This week we will consider the ways we reject God and how we tell others about Him. We will pray for repentant hearts and the words to share the gospel with our friends. We will practice discussing the way sin is a rejection of God with our friends.

SIN IS A REJECTION OF GOD



Read and meditate on Romans 1:18-25 this week.

- As you meditate on these verses consider your own heart and the ways you believe lies about God. Ponder how you can discuss with others some of the lies that we believe about God. How can you share your own struggles believing God is enough with your friends? How can you start a conversation about sin being a rejection of God?
- Ponder how you can use real world examples of worshiping the created instead of the Creator to talk about the gospel with your lost friends.



Spend time praying every day this week.

- As you pray, ask the Holy Spirit for wisdom to talk with your friends about the gospel. Pray for boldness to share the gospel and to talk with your friends.
- Spend time praying with your parent or small group leader this week. As you pray together, pray for a repentant heart and for opportunities to start conversations with your friends. Name some specific friends you'd like to share the gospel with in your prayers.



Spend some time thinking through ways you've encountered people worshiping created things rather than God.

- Make a list of some of these things and then seek to start a conversation with one friend about this topic. Think of a specific way you can turn the conversation to the gospel as you talk about it.
- Discuss with your small group leader ways to begin conversations about sin and the way we reject God. Come up with one conversation starter and choose a friend to use it on this week. Plan to meet again to discuss how it went.
