### BIBLE VERSE: ACTS 2:38

*“And Peter said to them, ‘Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.’”*

### BIG IDEAS

- Jesus is the only way anyone can be saved.
- Faith is trusting in Jesus as Savior and King.
- Repentance is turning from false saviors to pursue Jesus.

### BIBLE PASSAGE: ACTS 2:14-41

### KNEEL - I AM AN AMBASSADOR

The Kneel Year is an exploration of what it means to worship God with our all (Luke 10:26-28). Worship is not something that is limited to a service once a week, but instead occurs every day, in all of life. We are unceasing worshipers. Worship never stops, it only changes directions. In order to worship God with all of our heart, soul, strength, and mind, we must embrace our identity as image bearers. It is out of that identity that we can begin to live for God’s glory in all of life (Colossians 3:17).

### SERIES AIMS



#### Every student should know that...

- The gospel is the good news of Jesus Christ that brings salvation to sinners.
- Salvation comes by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone.
- Jesus followers have been trusted with the gospel in order to share it with others.



#### Every student should strive to...

- Share the gospel each month with at least one person who does not know Jesus.
- Practice sharing the gospel using multiple different tools or methods.



#### Every student should feel...

- Humbled that as believers we have been entrusted with the glorious gospel of our Savior.
- Satisfied in Jesus as the only true Savior



#### Every student should want...

- To grow in awareness of the false saviors they are tempted to put their hope in.
- To have a softened heart and love for people who are lost
- To take advantage of opportunities to share the gospel with people in their lives who need Christ

### FAMILY WORKOUT:

This week we will consider how to help our son or daughter understand what saving faith and repentance look like. We will pray with them to be bold and share their own personal salvation story with their lost friends. We will help them practice sharing their story and the gospel this week.

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**Read and meditate on Acts 2:14-41 this week.**

- As you meditate, consider your own salvation story and how you can model sharing it with lost people to your son or daughter. How can you discuss what true repentance looks like with your son or daughter.
- Ponder how you can lead your student in a discuss of faith and repentance this week. How can you help to answer any questions they may have about faith and repentance and how to use them to share the gospel with unbelievers?



**Pray every morning for your son or daughter before they leave the house.**

- Ask the Holy Spirit to make them bold in sharing their salvation experience with their friends.
- Pray with your student this week. As you pray together, ask the Holy Spirit to help them understand repentance and faith in a way that helps them share it with others.



**Share your own salvation story with your son or daughter to help them understand how to use their personal salvation story to share the gospel.**

- Talk through ways to share it effectively and in a way that helps others see their need for repentance.
- Talk through ways to share the gospel with your student this week. Encourage them to choose a person to share the gospel with this week and meet with them again to discuss how it went.
