BIG TRUTH: JESUS IS THE FOUNTAIN OF LIVING WATER

Jeremiah 2:13; 17:13; John 7:38; Revelation 7:17

BIBLE VERSE: JOHN 4:13-14

"Jesus said to her, 'Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.'"

BIG IDEAS

- False saviors always leave us empty and dry.
- Living water comes through right worship.
- Jesus pursues us in our brokenness and emptiness.

BIBLE PASSAGE: JOHN 4:1-45

KNEEL - I AM AN AMBASSADOR

The Kneel Year is an exploration of what it means to worship God with our all (Luke 10:26-28). Worship is not something that is limited to a service once a week, but instead occurs every day, in all of life. We are unceasing worshippers. Worship never stops, it only changes directions. In order to worship God with all of our heart, soul, strength, and mind, we must embrace our identity as image bearers. It is out of that identity that we can begin to live for God's glory in all of life (Colossians 3:17).

SERIES AIMS



Every student should know that...

- The gospel is the good news of Jesus Christ that brings salvation to sinners.
- Salvation comes by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone.
- Jesus followers have been trusted with the gospel in order to share it with others.



Every student should strive to...

- Share the gospel each month with at least one person who does not know Jesus.
- Practice sharing the gospel using multiple different tools or methods.



Every student should feel...

- Humbled that as believers we have been entrusted with the glorious gospel of our Savior.
- Satisfied in Jesus as the only true Savior



Every student should want...

- To grow in awareness of the false saviors they are tempted to put their hope in.
- To have a softened heart and love for people who are lost
- To take advantage of opportunities to share the gospel with people in their lives who need Christ

STUDENT WORKOUT:

This week we will ponder what it means to have the living water offered by Jesus. We will pray for a greater knowledge of the way God pursues us and we will practice telling others about this living water available to them.

JESUS IS THE FOUNTAIN OF LIVING WATER



Read and meditate on John 4:1-45 this week. As you read this story and meditate on it, ask yourself these questions:

- How have I seen God pursuing me?
- Do I have the living water that Jesus offered to the Samaritan woman?
- How has the living water changed me? What are some other things that I'm tempted to worship instead of Jesus?

Consider what it means to have the living water offered by Jesus. How can you share this good news with others? How is Jesus the true Savior and other things are false saviors? Is it easy to identify the false saviors in your life?



Set aside time to spend in prayer this week.

- As you pray, pray for a greater understanding of what it means to have living water. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to worship Jesus alone and to share the gospel with others.
- Spend time praying with your small group leader this week. As you pray together, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you to tell others about the way that Jesus pursues unbelievers.



Make a list of some of the false saviors that you are tempted to trust instead of Jesus.

- How do these false saviors fail you? How can you direct your heart and mind to worship Jesus alone this week?
- Spend time memorizing John 4:13-14 this week. Write the verses in a journal or on an index card. Spend time each day committing these verses to memory.
- Set aside time to discuss with your small group leader what it looks like to have living water in your life. How should your life look because you do have living water? What attitudes should characterize your life because of the living water inside of you?
