# FAMILY WORKOUT:

This week we will ponder how to discuss with our son or daughter the truth that the Spirit empowers us to witness for Him. We will pray for them to be witnesses for Him as we lead them to practice sharing the truth with their friends.



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#### Read Acts 1:1-11 and make notes in your journal. Answer the questions below in your journal:

- Read Acts 1:1-5. Why does Luke begin the book of Acts this way? What is he showing about Jesus?
  - In Acts 1:5, what promise is hinted at?
  - In Acts 1:6-11, what power does the Holy Spirit give to believers?
  - Why is this power unique and special?

#### Read and meditate on Acts 1:1-11 this week. Use these questions to guide your meditation:

- Ponder how to discuss with your son or daughter what it means to be a witness for Jesus.
- Consider what it means to model for your son or daughter being a witness to the ends of the earth.
- Ponder how you can lead your son or daughter to use the power of the Holy Spirit to be a witness for Jesus in all the earth.



- Ask God to help them use the power of the Holy Spirit to share the gospel with their friends.
- Pray with your student this week. Ask God to guide your student to live on mission, using the power of the Holy Spirit to be a witness for Jesus.

#### Memorize Acts 1:8 with your son or daughter this week.

- Write the verse on an index card. Review it each day to help them learn it.
- Discuss with your son or daughter some ways that you've been a witness for Jesus in other parts of the world or other areas of the country. Discuss ways that your son or daughter can be a witness one day in other parts of the world.
- Meet with your student to discuss mission opportunities. Share with your student some of the ways that he or she can get involved with the missions that your church is involved in in order to be a witness.
