BIG TRUTH: OUR PURPOSE AS IMAGE BEARERS IS THE GLORY OF GOD

Psalm 115:1; Isaiah 43:7, 21; Revelation 4:11; Colossians 3:23-24; Hebrews 13:15; 1 Chronicles 16:29; Psalm 100:3-4

BIBLE VERSE: 1 CORINTHIANS 10:31

"So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God."

BIG IDEAS

- God's glory is the chief end of man.
- Every moment is an opportunity for worship.
- God's glory is the purpose of the church and is magnified in community.

BIBLE PASSAGE: 1 CORINTHIANS 10:1-11:1

KNEEL - I AM AN IMAGE BEARER

The Kneel Year is an exploration of what it means to worship God with our all (Luke 10:26-28). Worship is not something that is limited to a service once a week, but instead occurs every day, in all of life. We are unceasing worshipers. Worship never stops, it only changes directions. In order to worship God with all of our heart, soul, strength, and mind, we must embrace our identity as image bearers. It is out of that identity that we can begin to live for God's glory in all of life (Colossians 3:17).

SERIES AIMS



Every student should know that...

- They were created in God's image and likeness for the purpose of worship.
- Value, purpose, significance, and worth are found in and flow from God alone.



Every student should strive to...

- Understand and embrace who God created them to be.
- Talk about gender and identity as a gift from the Lord for His purposes and His glory.
- Memorize the Bible verse each week.



Every student should feel...

- Awe that God created them in His own image.
- Loved by their heavenly Father who knows them better than they know themselves and still pursues them.



Every student should want...

- To have a deeper relationship with the God who made them in His image.
- To pursue a lifestyle of worship that centers on the true Savior and rejects false saviors.

FAMILY WORKOUT:

This week we will consider how to lead our son or daughter to glorify and worship God in every area of his or her life. We will pray for them to understand that God deserves all glory and we will lead them to practice worshiping and glorifying God in all areas of their lives.

Read and meditate on 1 Corinthians 10:1-11:1 this week.

- Consider how to discuss with your son or daughter what it means to live for God every day. How can you model glorifying God daily? How can you discuss with your son or daughter what it means to worship God every moment and in every circumstance?
- Consider how to lead your son or daughter to practice seeking God's glory through the local church. How can you help your child get plugged into your church in a way that he or she sees others seeking God's glory, too?



Spend time every morning praying for your son's or daughter's day.

- Pray that each day they would seek God's glory in all that they do.
- Set aside a time to pray with your student. Pray that the Holy Spirit would guide them to worship God in every moment and that they would not take moments for granted.



Discuss with your son or daughter how they can use their days to seek God's glory.

- Help them come up with a list of ways that they can glorify God in their daily activities.
- Discuss with your son or daughter how he or she sought to glorify God this week. Discuss some wins and some ways they can improve. Talk with them about how they can serve in their church as a way of seeking God's glory.
