BIBLE STORY: GENESIS 2

All that God made was perfect and good. When He made man and woman, they were good. He created them and gave them a place to live and work to do. Their work was good because work is a good gift from God. God also made them a family. Family is a good gift from God and it is His plan and design for the world.

THE STORY

The Story is the good news of the gospel. All of Scripture tells the Story of God the Father's work to redeem a people from the power of sin through God the Son so that they might live for His glory through the power of the Holy Spirit. During this series we will explore the four main movements of the Story of God, and our response to the life-altering Gospel Story!

BIG AIMS

- Memorize the Bible verse each week

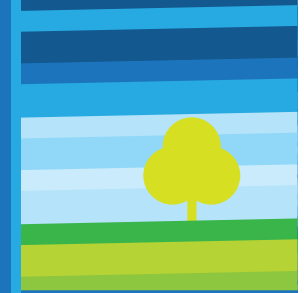


Every child should want:

FAMILY DEVOTION: GOD'S GOOD GIFTS

All that God does is good. The life He gives to all living things is a good gift. He gives work to His people as a good gift and He places people in families. God gives good gifts to His children and all that He does is good.

**BIBLE VERSE: GENESIS 1:31**

And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

God is always good.

“And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good.”

- God is good in every way. He is holy and righteous always. God has no sin and never does wrong. He is the supremely holy being. No one or thing is holy or righteous like God.
- Nothing can be righteous or holy apart from God. Good comes from Him because all things come from Him. He alone is perfectly good and righteous.

Everything God does is good.

“...it was very good.”

- Because He is good in every way, everything that He does is good. This means when He created the heavens and the earth, His creation was good. His design for the world was good and He created it perfectly.
- God does not change, so when He created man and woman, they were good and perfect. God’s design and purpose for them was good and is still good.

God’s design and purpose for creation is good.

“And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.”

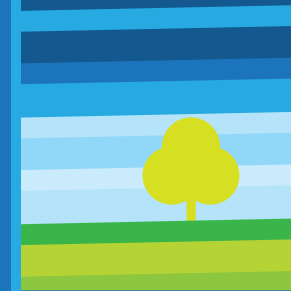
- God’s design for the world is good. The way the world functions and works is because of God’s design for it. We have morning and evening because God designed life to work that way. The sun rises and sets the way it does because of God’s plan and design. All of life functions as it does because of God’s good plan and design.
- God’s purpose for life is good. He made man and woman to live in families as part of His good purpose for them. He created work for them and gave them a place to live as part of His good purpose for them.

BIBLE STORY: GENESIS 2

God Made Everything Good

Opening Illustration:

Bring in toy food, animals, and pictures of different parts of creation. Have the preschoolers sit in a circle and then show them the items one at a time. Ask the preschoolers to label the items as good or bad. Once they label all of the items, ask the preschoolers to name some of the things that God created. Ask them if these things are good or bad. Tell them that everything that God made was good. Remind them that God is good and all that He created and all that He does was good.



BIG IDEA: LIFE IS A GOOD GIFT FROM GOD.¹

All life is a gift from God.

- Colossians 1:17 tells us that God holds all things together. He holds all of creation together and gives life to everything. Life is from God because He is the beginning of everything. All life comes from God and continues because God allows it to continue.
- Because God is sovereign over all and things exist only because He desires them to, every life is a gift from Him. People are born because God allows them to be born. People live because God allows them to live. He created the earth and it is held together by His power.



Bring in a gift-wrapped box. Inside the box, place a picture of living things, such as trees, people, or animals. Show the box to the children and have them take turns guessing what is inside of it. After the children guess, allow them to unwrap the box and look inside. Show them the picture of living things and tell them that life is a gift from God.

God created man and woman.

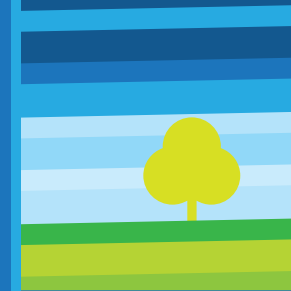
- God created the heavens and earth first and then on the sixth day of creation, He created mankind. After He created the first man, He placed him in the Garden of Eden. God then created a helper for Adam, the first man, when He created the first woman, Eve.
- People are God's design and His creation. Life is a good gift from God. Life is a good thing and can be celebrated and cherished because it is a gift and not something we have the ability to do for ourselves. That we are able to live with one another and enjoy God's creation is part of the goodness of life. We do not have to live this life alone, but get to live in families and as part of a community.

God made a home for man and woman.

- God created a home for the first man and woman. He set the Garden of Eden aside for Adam and Eve to live in. It was their home and had everything they needed for life and community. In their home, Adam and Eve had food, work, and relationships. They had community with one another and with God.
- God gave the earth for all of mankind to live in and populate. Earth is a gift from God and He allows us to continue living in it. God also gave man the responsibility of caring for the earth.

Who gives us life and allows us to continue living? (God gives life and it is a good gift from Him that He continues to give us.)

1. Genesis 1:31: Everything that God made was good and perfect because God is good and perfect.



BIG IDEA: WORK IS A GOOD GIFT FROM GOD.²

Work is from God.

- Work is not something that man created or designed. Work did not just happen. Work is from God. He created Adam and placed him in the Garden of Eden. God gave Adam work when He placed him in the Garden of Eden. Adam had purpose in naming the animals and caring for the earth.
- Work is a good gift from God. Work existed before man's sin in the Garden of Eden. It is part of God's design for the world and mankind. It is good and reveals God's character and nature.



Bring in pictures of people in different jobs, such as fireman, nurse, doctor, teacher, businessman, etc. Show the pictures to the children and ask them to talk about each job. Remind them that work is from God and it's a good gift.

God gave work to man as part of His design for creation's good.

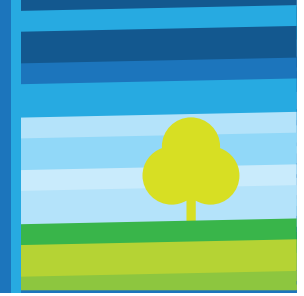
- Work before the Fall was different than work after the Fall.
- When God gave work to Adam, it was a good and pleasant thing. It was designed for creation's good and is still good for man now. Before the Fall, work was not hard or difficult. It was part of man's life and was very good.
- After the Fall, work became difficult and man's sinful nature distorted it. Though sin has distorted work, work is still good for creation and mankind. Work is the way that God designed people to live and exist. It gives purpose and joins people together as a community. It profits creation and brings God glory.

Work is part of every person's created purpose.

- Work is for all people. Not every person will work in the same way or same job, but working is part of God's design for people. Throughout Scripture, God speaks against idleness or laziness. He created people to utilize their gifts and abilities for His glory and the good of the world.
- Part of man's purpose is to care for his earthly home. In the Garden of Eden, God first gave this purpose to Adam. Every person has this responsibility now to be a good steward of the earthly home that God has given us and continues to sustain for us. When we embrace work as God's design for us, even now, we can find joy in it.

Who gave us work? (God gave work as part of His purpose for mankind.)

2. Genesis 2:15: God created work for man before the Fall and work was a good gift from Him.



BIG IDEA: FAMILY IS A GOOD GIFT FROM GOD.³

Family is God's idea and design.

- When God created the world, His design for mankind was good and perfect. God designed people to live in community and relationship with one another. God created Adam and placed him in the Garden of Eden. He then created Eve as Adam's companion and wife.
- When God created Eve, He made the first family. God created a man and a woman to live as husband and wife and to give birth to children. This is God's design for family. Placing people in families is from God. It is not something that Adam decided and made happen. It is something that God did for Adam.



Use a large piece of paper and take turns tracing all or a few of the preschoolers. Have the preschoolers draw clothes, hair, and other articles on the people they traced. Talk with them about how God made family and it is good and for His glory.

Family is for God's glory and mankind's good.

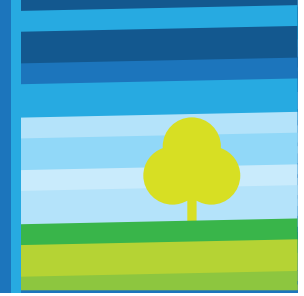
- God designed people for community because He is a communal God. God is relational and He created people to be relational. Because this is God's design for people, He gave them a way to meet this relational and communal need by creating families. People weren't designed to live alone in isolation.
- Because family is from God it is for His glory and mankind's good. Family is not just for man's good. It is for God's glory and it brings God glory when it is according to His design. Family is also for the good of people. Living in families brings people happiness and joy.

God's design for family is good and perfect.

- God's design for family is perfect. When He created Adam and Eve, He gave them instructions to multiply on the earth, meaning they should have children. A man and woman joining together as husband and wife and then having children is God's design for family.
- God's design is good and perfect. It is what is best for mankind and it is what brings God glory.

Whose design is best for family? (God's design is perfect and good.)

3. Genesis 2:18: God made the first family when He gave Adam a companion.



CHURCH HOOKS



KNOW

GOOD VERSUS BAD

Bring in items that children would think of as good and items they'd think of as bad. Place the items in a bag and have the children take turns drawing an item out and labeling it as good or bad. After each item has been labeled talk with them about how God made everything good.

- God is a good God and everything He does is good. • When He made creation, His creation was good.
- All that He made is good because He is good.



DO

ALL THINGS GOOD

Talk with the preschoolers about the good things that God created, such as family, friends, animals, work, etc. Have them sit in a circle and pass a beanbag around the circle. Play music while they pass the beanbag. When the music stops, the child holding the beanbag gets to name one good thing that God created. Once every child has a chance to name something, talk with them about how God made everything good.

- All that God made was good.
- He gave us family and work because it is good and good for us. God gave us life as a good gift.



FEEL



WANT

GOOD GOOD FATHER

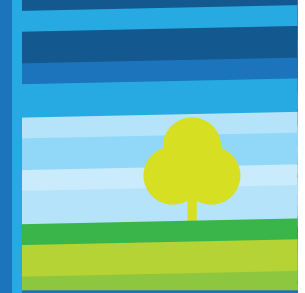
Play the song "Good Good Father" and sing it with the children. Talk about how God is good and everything He made is good.

As family, memorize Genesis 1:31. Play a game of freeze tag with your child. When a person is frozen, they can be unfrozen by saying the verse or part of it.

As a family, create a family tree using craft supplies, such as yarn, felt, etc. Talk with your child about how family is a good gift from God. Remind them that family is God's design and is good for us.

Set aside a time to share with your child the things you enjoy about work. Talk with your child about how work is from God and is a good thing. Help your child name some jobs that he or she can do around your house.

Set aside time to pray with your child everyday this week. Pray for your child to understand that life is a gift from God and is good.

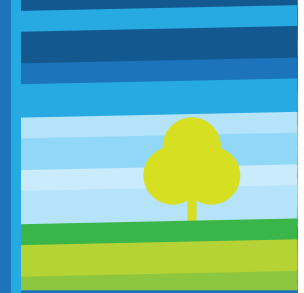

GOD'S GOOD GIFTS

As a family, plan a family day or evening. Ask your preschooler to help you plan the day or family time together. As you plan, focus on the truth that family is a good gift from God. During your family day or time, talk with your child about how God gave us family as a good gift for His glory and our good.

DISCOVER IT: *(Use the passage to illustrate the Big Truth.)*

Genesis 2

THINK ABOUT IT: *(Use the commentary to reinforce the Big Truth.)*

Because God is the Creator of all things, everything He made is good. He is a good and perfect God. Life is a gift from God. Adam did not create himself. Adam also did not create Eve. God made Adam and breathed life into his nostrils. After He created Adam and placed him in the Garden of Eden, God created a companion for Adam. God made Eve and gave her to Adam as his wife. When God made Adam and Eve, He created the first family. It is God's design that we live in families. This is another of God's good gifts to us. God also gave Adam jobs to do, or work. Adam was in charge of naming the animals, caring for them, and looking after the earth. Adam and Eve lived together in the Garden of Eden and each of their days had purpose because God gave them work. Work is also a good gift from God. God created us to work and to fulfill His purpose for our lives. Our lives have purpose and meaning because of God's design for us. Life, work, and family are all part of God's goodness to us and reveal to us that He is the good Creator.

TALK ABOUT IT: *(Use the questions to discuss the Big Truth)*

- What are some of God's good gifts to us? (God gave us life, work, and family as good gifts.)
- Why are these gifts good to us and for us? (They bring meaning and purpose to our life.)



KNOW

Help your child memorize Genesis 1:31 by creating word art from the verse. Write the verse on a piece of paper and help your child decorate it. As you decorate it, say the verse out loud together several times.



DO

Create a list of small jobs for your child to do this week, such as putting away their toys, helping set the table, etc. Talk with your child about how work is a good gift from God.



FEEL

Spend time talking with your child about family and how it is a good gift from God. Talk with your child about God's design for family—a man and woman living as husband and wife and their children. Share with your child some of your favorite things about your family and ask your child to share some of their favorite things about your family.



WANT

Each morning this week pray with your child, thanking God for the good gift of life, family, and work.
