BIG TRUTH: WE ARE UNWORTHY SERVANTS

1 Chronicles 29:14; 1 Corinthians 1:27; Romans 11:35; Ephesians 3:8; 1 Timothy 1:15; 1 Corinthians 15:9-10

BIBLE VERSE: LUKE 17:10

"So you also, when you have done all that you were commanded, say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty."

BIG IDEAS

- A servant's purpose is to serve his master.
- The master does not owe the servant anything.
- We wholeheartedly serve Jesus knowing that we are unworthy of His grace.

BIBLE PASSAGE: LUKE 17:7-10

UNITE - I AM CALLED

The Unite Year is an exploration of what it means to be united in Christ as the family of God (Romans 12:5). When we are saved, we are given a spirit of adoption as sons (Romans 8:15-16), are made a child of God, and we are also saved into a family- the Church. The Unite Year explores how we are to live as a part of a family, and to live in light of our calling as servants and disciples of Christ. We use our gifts to build up the church as we pursue unity, humility, and gentleness with our brothers and sisters in Christ (Ephesians 4:1-2).

SERIES AIMS



Every student should know that...

- They are a servant of Jesus.
- They have been forgiven an unimaginable debt.
- To be a servant means to lay down their lives



Every student should strive to...

- Forgive anyone who has wronged them as Jesus has forgiven them.
- Walk by faith instead of giving into anxiety.
- Be known by their allegiance to Christ and the gospel.



Every student should feel...

- Awe at the forgiveness they have experienced in Christ.
- Thankful for the grace that brought them from death to life and into God's family.
- Unworthy of the mercy and grace they have received



Every student should want...

- To be faithful and pursue obedience to God.
- To sacrifice their comfort and control for the sake of the gospel.
- To be committed to Christ above all else.

FAMILY WORKOUT:

This week we will ponder how to discuss with our son or daughter our unworthiness as servants of God. We will pray for them to have hearts that desire to serve God. We will lead them to practice living as servants of God daily.



Read and meditate on Luke 17:7-10 this week.

As you ponder these verses, ask yourself some of these questions:

- How can you model serving Jesus this week? What are some ways you can help your son or daughter understand the grace of God and our unworthiness of it?
- How can you help your son or daughter understand their purpose of serving God?

Consider ways you can discuss with your son or daughter what it looks like to serve God wholeheartedly.



Spend time praying for your son or daughter this week.

- As you pray for them ask the Holy Spirit to guide them to a greater understanding of their unworthiness as a servant of God.
- Pray with your student this week. As you pray with them, model asking the Holy Spirit for opportunities to serve God and others.



Discuss with your son or daughter ways that he or she can serve others this week.

- Help them make a list of activities or people that they can serve.
- Discuss with your student ways that he or she can serve in the church this week. Help them choose one or two ways to serve God and others through the church.
