BIG TRUTH: JESUS IS THE FULFILLMENT OF THE LAW

BIBLE VERSE: MATTHEW 5:17

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them."

BIG IDEAS

- All of Scripture points to Jesus.
- All of Scripture is relevant and authoritative for all of life.
- All of Scripture points to our need for a righteousness found outside of ourselves.

BIBLE PASSAGE: MATTHEW 5:17-20

TRANSFORM - I AM GROWING

The Transform Year is an exploration of what it means to become a "new creation" in Jesus. (2 Corinthians 5:17) In order for this to happen, we must first find our identity in Him. Many of us live in a consistent state of identity crises. We wrestle with questions like who am I, where do I belong, why do I exist? The answer to these questions is found in Jesus. Our prayer for this semester is that like the Apostle Paul we would be able to say, "I have been crucified with Christ, it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me." (Galatians 2:20).

FAMILY WORKOUT

This week we will consider how to help our son or daughter understand the authority and relevance of Scripture to every part of our lives. We will pray with our student for wisdom and knowledge concerning areas of their lives that need to be realigned with God's Word. We will help our son or daughter practice using Scripture to share the gospel.

Read and meditate upon Matthew 5:17-20 this week.

- Consider how you can lead your son or daughter to a greater understanding of the relevance of Scripture to his or her life. How can you model submitting to the authority of Scripture for your son or daughter?

Consider how to help your son or daughter understand that they need a righteousness outside of themselves.

- How can you share with your child verses that show our righteousness is not good enough? In what ways can you help your child grow in their understanding of their need for Jesus? If your child knows Jesus, how can you help your child submit to the authority of God's Word?



Pray with your son or daughter this week.

- As you pray, ask the Holy Spirit to give your son or daughter a greater understanding of the relevance of Scripture to every part of our lives.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help your son or daughter live a life submitted to the authority of Scripture.



Discuss with your child some social issues or ideas that are not specifically mentioned in the Bible.

- Help your son or daughter see that God's Word offers wisdom and authority on every issue.
- Discuss with your son or daughter ways to use Scripture to share the Gospel with lost friends and family members. Make a plan to use Scripture to share the gospel with someone to model for your son or daughter how to use Scripture to share the Gospel.
